

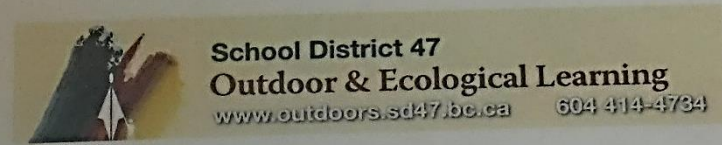

- Cardstock

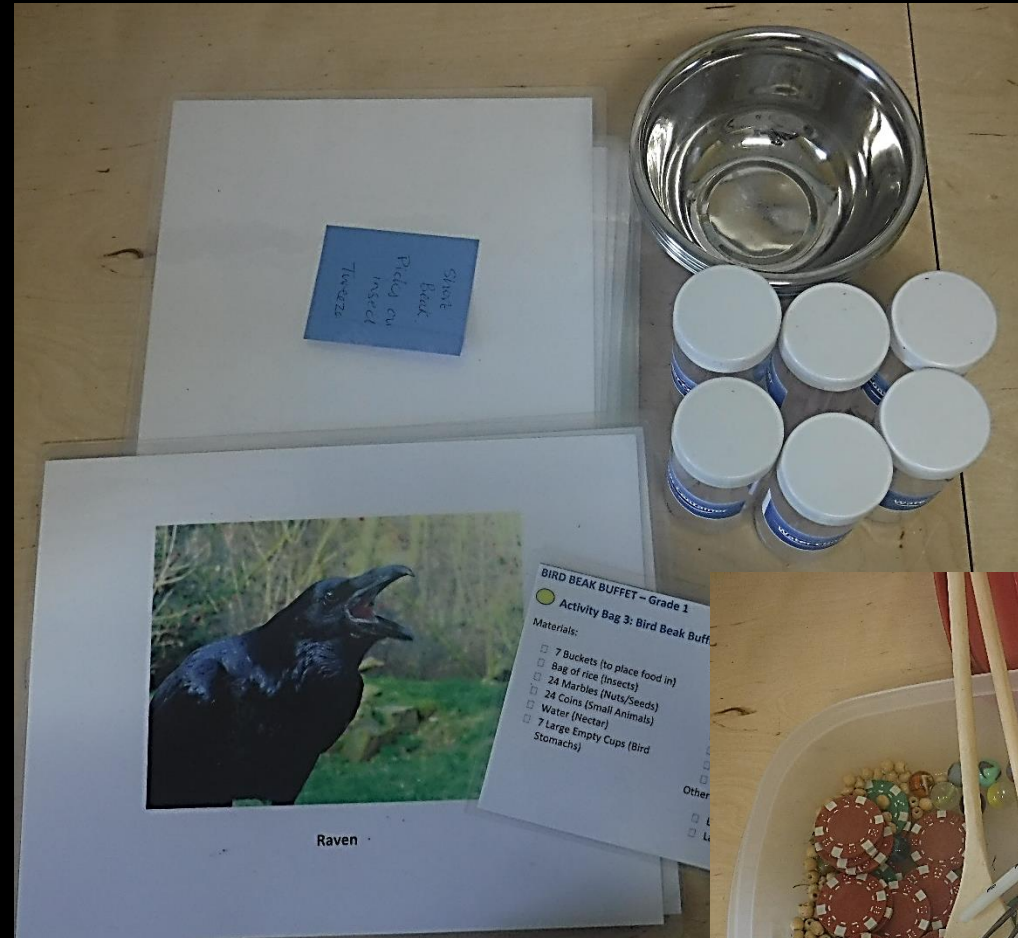


Activity 3: Bird Beak Buffet

- 7 metal bowls (to place food in)
- 1 Bag of Rice
- 7 water jars with lids
- Local Bird Picture Cards

Beaks & Bird "Food" (in large plastic container)

- Lots of marbles/beads (nuts/seeds)
- Poker chips (small animals)
- 2 wooden spoons
- 2 chopsticks
- 1 Pair of Scissors
- 1 Pair of tongs
- 1 Pair of tweezers
- 1 Garlic press
- 1 Eye dropper



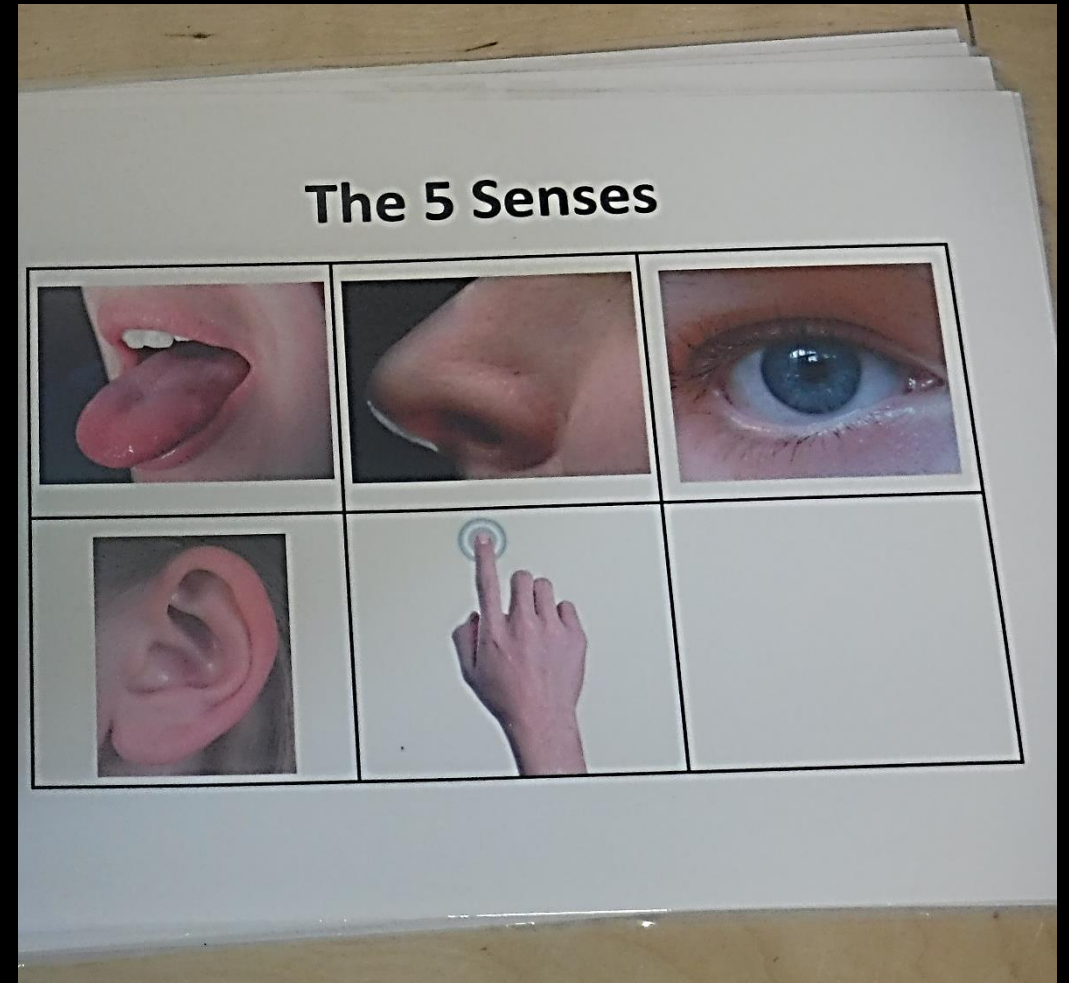
Activity 4: Bird Watching
